Château Bel Air Ouÿ Saint Emilion Grand Cru

Following the purchase of Château Bel Air Ouÿ on the commune of Saint-Etienne de Lisse, Jean-Luc Thunevin vinified the first vintage in 1999.

The vineyard is located on a great clayey limestone terroir. The vines are carefully driven by Murielle and her team, exactly the same way as Chateau Valandraud.

Lush and inviting, with deliciously creamy and nicely toasty dark boysenberry, blackberry and steeped raspberry fruit. There's lots of anise and toasted spice inlaid on the finish, which coats the palate, with ample length. Best from 2014 through 2022. JM
