## Clos Badon Thunevin Saint Emilion Grand Cru

This property is located in Saint Emilion since the 19<sup>th</sup> century

This vineyard is down the famous Côte Pavie slopes, between Château Pavie and Château Larcis Ducasse

Bought by Thunevin back in 1998, Clos Badon has been managed by the same team that works for Château Valandraud
