This property has been purchased in 2006 by Jean Luc Thunevin and Murielle Andraud

Composed of 3 separate plots of land on the Lalande de Pomerol commune, the estate has grown in 2009 through the addition of 3 ha in Néac.

Domaine des Sabines is the name that the previous owners had chosen as a tribute to their daughter, named Sabine. Domaine des Sabines is clearly an ambassador of the right bank wines, pursuing the quest of purity, maturity and elegance, as Pomerol and Lalande de Pomerol wines are renowned to be.

Tasting notes

The **2015** Domaine des Sabines is a blend of 90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc. This has a punchy, feisty nose with small dark cherries and blueberry fruit. The palate is medium-bodied with saturated tannin.

Espresso infuses the soft black fruit and it segues effortlessly into an easy-going finish that slips down the throat with ease. It has got "drinkability" plastered all over it.
