80 % of the estate is located in the “René” area of Pomerol.

This estate has been purchased by Jean-Luc Thunevin in 2006, which will be the debut vintage of this growth, previously known as Chateau Ratouin or Angélus in the 19th century.

Soils : deep gravels

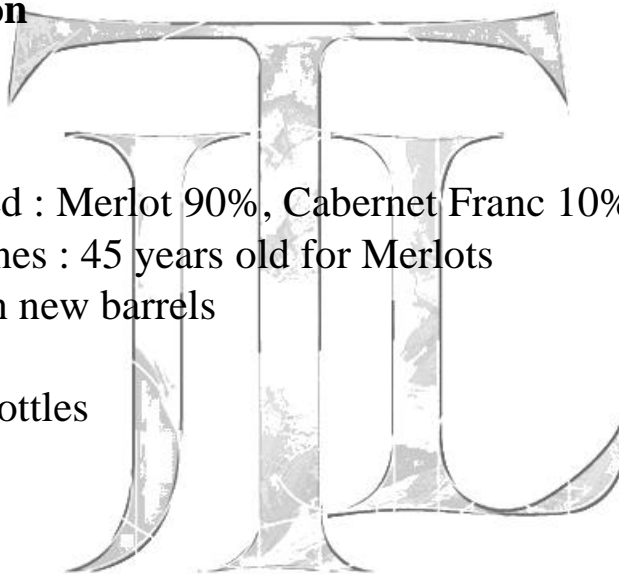
Grape varieties planted : Merlot 90%, Cabernet Franc 10%

Kirsch and plum paste notes form the core, featuring a wrapping of black licorice on the finish. Frankly toasted, this should be fairly direct when bottled.
