Clos Badon Saint Emilion Grand Cru

Clos Badon is an old vineyard estate house from the XX century which became famous for its elegant wines.

The property was acquired by Jean Luc Thunevin and his wife Murielle Andraud in 1998, after their tremendous success with Chateau Valandraud, the 1st Grand Cru Classé of St Emilion since 2012.

Murielle Andraud has taken in hand the control of the vineyard.

The 2016 Clos Badon-Thunevin is just as gorgeous from bottle as it was from barrel. Sumptuous, racy and inviting, the 2016 has so much to offer. As always, Clos Badon is a rich, heady Saint-Émilion. Super-ripe blackberry, chocolate, espresso and spice build into the creamy, super-expressive finish. The blend is 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Franc. *Antonio Galloni*
