Tasting Notes

The Bad Boy "Syrah" 2014 actually has a more complex and appealing bouquet than the regular Bad Boy bottling with attractive floral, violet notes blossoming from the glass and expressing the variety with style. The palate is not quite on the same level as the aromatics, but it is nicely balanced with plenty of cocoa and dark chocolate to enjoy on the finish. It's just a fun Bordeaux wine - no more, no less.
